

About the Program

Dealer Members of the GCADA, in co-operation with the NADA Charitable Foundation have the opportunity to provide CPR training manikins to Greater Cincinnati area hospitals, police, fire departments, schools, and local Red Cross chapters. Across the country, automobile dealerships have provided an estimated 4,600 manikins worth approximately \$3 million, for training of over 2 million people, potentially saving thousands of lives.

It costs your dealership nothing to donate.

Any CPR is better than none. If you find yourself in a situation where someone is in need of CPR...

- First, CALL 911, then you may begin performing what is called "Bystander CPR."
- Hands-only CPR is typically all that is needed until help arrives.
- Place the heel of one hand in the middle of the person's chest, then clasp it with your other hand.
- Keep your arms straight, and as close to 90 degrees from the body as possible.
- Then begin aggressive compressions. These compressions should be to the beat of the Bee Gee's 1977 disco classic "Stayin' Alive." This should be about 100 compressions per minute.
