

People Must Be Trained – CPR Awareness

WEST CHESTER, OH – On Thursday, October 30, 2014, the Greater Cincinnati Automobile Dealers Association, in conjunction with the National Automobile Dealers Charitable Foundation (NADCF) donated Little Anne Four Pack Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation manikin bag, to Southern Ohio Personal Safety.

This donation will assist the department's efforts in training individuals on this important life-saving skill set. Fairfield Volkswagen, the sponsoring organization, presented the manikins at their dealership to Ronald J. Shands of Southern Ohio Personal Safety.

The NADCF has been donating manikins to organizations for nearly 40 years. Since they began in 1975, they've donated over 4,600 manikins to organizations in all 50 states and Washington D.C. These manikins have trained over 2 million people, saving thousands of lives.
